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1 The court having considered the Complaint, supporting
2 declarations, exhibits, and points and authorities submitted
3 in support of Plaintiffs' Motion for a Temporary Restraining
4 Order, and good cause being shown that this is a proper case
5 for issuance of an order to show cause and a temporary
6 restraining order, the Court finds that Plaintiff is likely
7 to succeed on the merits or at least that sufficiently
8 serious questions going to the merits of the case have been
9 established to make them a fair ground for litigation and
10 that unless the temporary restraining order issues
11 immediately and without notice, Plaintiffs will suffer
12 irreparable harm by way of loss of trade secrets in
13 connection with its confidential religious documents.

14 THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

15 1. That Defendants show cause before this court at
16 courtroom 15 of the United States Courthouse at 312 North
17 Spring Street, Los Angeles, California, on the 8th day of
18 November, 1985 at 4:30 o'clock P. m., or as soon thereafter
19 as counsel can be heard, why a preliminary injunction,
20 pursuant to Rule 65, F.R.C.P., should not issue enjoining
21 Defendants, their agents, servants, employees, attorneys and
22 those person in active concert or participation with them or
23 who are acting at their request or insistence who receive
24 actual notice by personal service or otherwise, and each of
25 them, pending the final hearing and determination of this

15 locked storage cabinet or safe;

16 (d) Prohibiting Defendants from distributing all

19 (e) enjoining Defendants from using all confidential

22 2. That pending the hearing and determination of

3 3. ORDERED that Plaintiffs shall post a bond in a form
4 approved by the court in the sum of \$ 5,000. ^{by 12:00 p.m.} as ¹¹⁻⁶⁷
5 security for the payment of such costs and damages as may be
6 incurred or suffered by any party who is subsequently found
7 to be wrongfully enjoined or restrained hereby;

8 4. That service of the Summons and Complaint and of
9 this Order together with copies of the papers in support
10 thereof, may be made by Plaintiffs' attorneys or their duly
11 qualified agents or employees on Defendants on or before
